Birthright	Created in God's image, given dominion over the earth (Genesis 1:26-28)	Birthright of Reuben given to Joseph because of Reuben's sin (1 Chronicles 5:1, 2)	Firstborn among many brethren (Romans 8:29)	
Clothing	Coat of skins made by God to cover their nakedness - blood shed (Genesis 3:21) - death to cover sin	Joseph's coat of many colors was dipped in blood - blood shed (Genesis 37:31) - death to cover sin	Vesture dipped in blood - blood shed (Revelation 19:13) - death to take away sin	blood shed
Death	At 930 years (Genesis 5:5)	His brothers planned to kill him out of envy (Genesis 37:18-20)	The Israelites, with a mock trial, and the Gentiles, who carried out the execution, participated in killing Jesus	All of mankind guilty in the death of Jesus
Dominion	Was given dominion over the earth to tend it and keep it, because of his sin the earth "rebelled", was cursed by God (Genesis 2:15, Romans 8:20, 21)	Was taken from prison and given dominion in Egypt in one day (Genesis 41:1-46)	Was resurrected from death and given an everlasting kingdom (Luke 11:33, Revelation 11:15)	
Fellowship	Enjoyed fellowship with his Father (God) until he disobeyed God's law (Genesis 3:8)	Enjoyed fellowship with his father (Jacob), the favorite of his father, until he was rejected by his brothers and sent away (Genesis 37:18-36)	Enjoyed fellowship with His Father in heaven until He purposely set it aside in obedience to His Father and for our sake (Philippians 2:5-11), always did that which pleased His Father (John 8:29)	
Forgiveness		Joseph forgave his brothers, God meant it for good (Genesis 50:16-21)	Jesus died to provide forgiveness, God meant Jesus' death for the good of His people	
Guiltiness	Was guilty in eating from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil (Genesis 3:7, 11, 17)	Was accused of wrongdoing, but was not guilty (Genesis 39:16-18)	Knew no sin (2 Corinthians 5:21)	
Name	Named Adam by God (male and female) (Genesis 5:2)	Named Zaphnath-paaneah by Pharaoh, one who discovers hidden things (Genesis 41:45)	Named by the angel (Matthew 1:21, Luke 1:31)	
Obedience	Disobeyed the LORD in the matter of eating from the tree (Genesis 2:16, 17, Genesis 3:6, 7)	Obedied the Lord in the matter of Potiphar's wife, "How can I do this great wickedness and sin against God?" (Genesis 39:9), before the law was given (Exodus 20)	Was obedient unto death (Philippians 2:8), Always pleased His Father (Matthew 3:17, Matthew 17:5, Mark 1:11, Luke 3:22, John 8:29, 2 Peter 1:17)	
Possession	Because of his sin Adam and his family were taken out of the garden, removed from the best situation, and prevented from returning (Genesis 3:23, 24)	Joseph gave his family the best of Egypt (Genesis 47:11)	Believers have the promise of eternity with Him, in the best situation	
Relation to the land	Given the garden to keep it, lost it upon sinning (Genesis 2:15)	Joseph bought the land of Egypt for Pharaoh (Genesis 47:20, 23)	The Father reconciled the world to Himself through the sacrifice of Jesus (2 Corinthians 5:18)	Garden to Egypt to the world
Remembrance	Remembered for his sin against God (Romans 5:12-21, 1 Corinthians 15:22, 35-49)	Gave command concerning his bones, not to be buried in Egypt but in Canaan, to be carried into Canaan when they left (Genesis 50:25, Exodus 13:19, Joshua 24:32, Hebrews 11:22)	Jesus gave commandment concerning remembrance of Him as we wait His return (1 Corinthians 11:23-26)	
Revelation	Communed with God before his sin, ran from God afterwards (Genesis 3:8)	Named Zaphnath-paaneah by Pharaoh, one who discovers hidden things (Genesis 41:45)	Jesus' life and mission was a revelation of mysteries (Romans 16:25, Ephesians 5:32, Ephesians 6:19, Colossians 1:26, 27, 1 Timothy 3:16)	
Sold		Joseph sold into slavery for twenty pieces of silver (Genesis 37:28)	Jesus sold to death by Judas for thirty pieces of silver (Zechariah 11:12, 13, Matthew 26:15, Matthew 27:9)	
View of God	Blamed God for the sin that he had committed (Genesis 3:12)	Gave glory to God before interpreting the dreams (Genesis 40:8, Genesis 41:16)	I do always the things that please Him (John 8:29), the world will honor Jesus to the glory of His Father (Philippians 2:11)	
Wept		Joseph wept because of his brothers (Genesis 43:30, Genesis 45:1)	Jesus wept over Jerusalem (Luke 19:41), and at the death of Lazarus (John 11:35)	
Worship		His brothers bowed to him (Genesis 37:7, Genesis 37:10, Genesis 42:6, Genesis 43:26, Genesis 43:28, Genesis 44:14, Genesis 50:18)	Every knee shall bow and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God (Philippians 2:10, 11)
